Counselling Session for Teachers



A Counselling Session for teachers was held on 9th March'23 on the topic: Early Identification and Intervention for Children in need of Mental Health and Well-Being Support - A Guide for Teachers.

Highlights of the session:

- 1. Various mental health needs and concerns of children and adolescents were discussed, namely- Depression, Anxiety, Loss and Grief, Problematic Internet Use, Disruptive Behaviours, Gender Identity and Sexual Orientation.
- 2. The statistics regarding impact of the above concerns and the various flag signs to identify children in need of mental health support were also deliberated upon.
- 3. Reflections on the role of the teacher as a support system and as first responders were emphasized upon.
- 4. Ideas for classroom changes that can be made to encourage self-regulation were also suggested.
- 5. Materials and tools were shared with teachers for further psycho-education on learning skills in managing children and other stakeholders involved.
