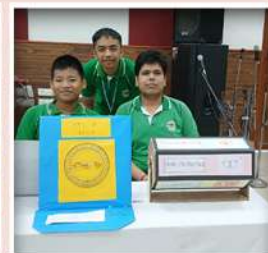

SUMMER ART CAMP

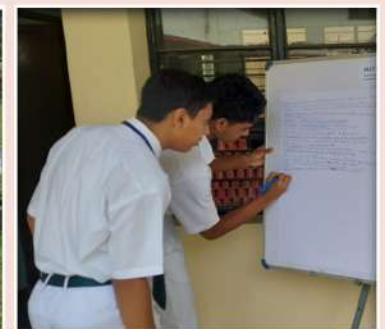
