

EVALUATION SYSTEM FOR CLASSES - I & II

Evaluation system is as follows :

1. Three term assessments during the entire academic session- Term –I, II & III
2. During each term both the scholastic and co-scholastic areas will be assessed.
3. The details of these areas are :

4. Assessment Criteria for Scholastic Areas :

- i) For the subjects (English, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Studies) the weightage will be 50 for each term, out of which 40 marks will be for written exam and 10 marks will be for oral exam.
- ii) For Assamese and Bodo the weightage will be 30 for each term, out of which 25 marks will be for written exam and 5 marks will be for oral exam.

5. Assessment Criteria for Co-Scholastic areas :

- i) Assessment for the following areas will be done thrice at the end of Term I, II and III on day-to-day observation basis as well on overall performance at the end of each term:
1. Art Education 2. Health and Physical Education 3. . Activity (SUPW) 4. Discipline
- ii) For Computer Science, three Assessments will be conducted for **Class II** where Grades will be allotted. There will be no Computer Science Assessment for Class I.

Promotion Criteria :

The general criterion for promotion of students of classes I & II will be as per school rules.

CRITERIA OF ASSESSMENT

1. For subjects **English, Hindi, Mathematics, Science & Social Science/Studies** :

a) No. of Weekly Tests to be conducted during the entire session : Three(3), per subject.

b) Full Marks (each test) : 20 Duration: 1 hou.

c) No. of Terminal Exams to be conducted during the entire session : Two(2)

d) Full Marks (each exam) : 60 Duration : 2 ½ Hous.

e) **Internal Assessment** will be conducted for 20 Marks
Practical Activity– 10 Marks + Subject Enrichment Activities(A) – 5Marks + Note Book – 5 Marks

2. For subjects **Assamese/Bodo/Sanskrit & Computer Science** :

a) No. of Weekly Tests to be conducted during the entire session : Two(2)), per subject.

b) Full Marks (each test) : 20 Duration: 1 hou.

c) No. of Terminal Exams to be conducted during the entire session : Two(2)

d) Full Marks (each exam) : 30 Duration : 1 ½ Hous.

e) **Internal Assessment** will be conducted for 10 Marks
For A/B/S –
Practical Activity– 5 Marks + Subject Enrichment Activities(A) –2.5Marks + Note Book – 2.5 Marks
For Computer Science - Only Practical Activity– 10 Marks.

3. **COMPUTATION OF MARKS FOR ANNUAL RESULT CALCULATION** :

For subjects English, Hindi, Maths, Science and Social studies/science

a) Best two test marks out of three tests will be taken for calculation. (No retest will be conducted for a test, missed)

b) Test-1(20) + Test-2(20) + Term-1 Exam(60) + Term -2 Exam(60) = 160(Total)

c) 50% of this total marks(i.e. 50% of 160) will be taken to obtain marks out of 80.

d) Internal Assessment Marks out of 20 will be added to 80 to make the total marks for each subject as 100.

For subjects Assamese/Bodo/Sanskrit & Computer Science

a) Best(one) test mark out of two tests will be taken for calculation. (No retest will be conducted for a test, missed)

b) Test-(20) + Term -1 Exam(30) + Term -2 Exam(30) = 80(Total)

c) 50% of this total marks(i.e. 50% of 80) will be taken to obtain marks out of 40.

d) Internal Assessment Marks out of 10 will be added to 40 to make the total marks for each subject as 50.

After Final Computation of Marks for each subject, the marks will be graded as per the following criteria :

IV) Assessment Criteria for Scholastic Areas :

- > For the subjects (English, Hindi/Assamese/Bodo/Sanskrit, Maths, Science & Social Science) under scholastic areas there will be three weekly tests conducted during the entire session. The weightage of each test will be 25 and duration will be 1 hour. Two best test marks will be considered for Internal Assessment.
- > For Information Technology two weekly tests, each of 25 marks will be conducted, one before half yearly exam and other before Annual Exam.
- > To calculate the final result For the subjects (English, Hindi/Assamese/Bodo/Sanskrit, Mathematics, Science & Social Science), Annual Exam of 80 marks and Internal Assessment of 20 marks
- > Internal Assessment includes, Weekly Test and Half Yearly Exam (5 marks) + Multiple Assessment (5 Marks) + Portfolio (5 Marks) + Subject Enrichment Activity (5 Marks)

V) Assessment Criteria for Co-Scholastic Areas :

Grade will be given for the following areas once in the session, during the annual result.

- 1) To assess the scholastic area, there will be weekly test, Half Yearly Examination & Annual Examination/Pre-Board Exams during the entire academic session.
- 2) The details of the scholastic areas are :

- 3) Assessment Criteria for Scholastic Areas :
 - For All the subjects there will be three weekly tests conducted during the entire session for class XII and two weekly tests for class XI. The weightage of each test will be 30 and duration will be 1 hour. The total marks of weekly tests will be added and will be calculated out of 100.
 - Half yearly & Annual Exam will be conducted consisting of Theory & Practical/Project as per marks allotted by CBSE for a particular subject.
 - The final result will be calculated by taking 25% of Weekly Tests + 25% of Half Yearly + 50% of Annual Exam.

PROMOTION CRITERIA

1. There will be no formal examination for Play group I & II
2. There will be three terminal evaluations conducted for classes I and II.
3. The general criterion for promotion of students of classes III to V will be as per school rules.
4. In order to be declared as having passed, for classes VI to VIII, a student must obtain at least grade D in all subjects under scholastic area in the final computation of marks.
5.
 - a) In order to be declared as having passed, the final evaluation of class IX and Pre-Board of X, a student must obtain at least 33% out of 80 marks in Annual Examination/Pre-Board and 33% out of 20 marks in the Internal Assessment.
 - b) There is provision for compartmental examination for class IX students, failing to obtain 33% in two subjects.
 - c) The compartmental examination for class IX is the substitute of Annual Examination.
6.
 - a) In order to be declared as having passed, the final evaluation of class XI and Pre-Board of XII, a student must obtain at least 33% marks in all subjects in Annual result/Pre-Board result. In case of subjects involving practical work, a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and in practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate.
 - b) There is provision of compartmental Examination, for class XI students who fail to obtain 33% in one subject.
 - c) The compartmental Exam for class XI is the substitute of Annual Examination.
